#### C. PROGRESS OF SECTION 1332 WAIVER - General

- 12. Provide an update on progress made in implementing and/or operating the approved 1332 waiver.
- (1) Operational Expenses. All operational expenses have been paid from draws on the federal grant. Claims for the 2021 year which are pending reimbursement to carriers will be funded by a combination of state funds and federal grant funds. These claims were submitted on or before August 15, 2022, to the program administrator and will be paid by December 31, 2022. Detail of the claims will be provided in the annual report.
- (2) Updates to the Plan of Operation. A history of the payment parameters throughout the years has been added to the Plan of Operation. The Board of Directors will continue to maintain and update the Plan of Operation as needed.
- (3) Cost Containment. CSI is working with the carriers on reporting utilization review statistics related to cost containment measures. Any information gathered through this process will be provided to CMS at a later date.
- (4) Premium Base for Assessments. The Board and CSI discussed amending the definition of Premium Base for assessments purposes. Such amendment would require legislative approval. Upon further review, it was determined the proposal would not significantly expand membership for the additional dollars collected. Montana is no longer considering expanding the assessment base.

- (5) Pass through funding report. The Pass through funding report was submitted to CMS before September 23, 2022.
- (6) 2023 Proposed Legislation. Montana's 2023 legislative session (68th regular session) will start on Monday, January 2, 2023 and is scheduled to end late April/early May 2023. As of the date of this report's submission, the CSI, with the Board's input and consent, will propose a legislative change to the Montana Reinsurance Association Act (Title 33, chapter 22, part 13, Montana Code Annotated). Specifically the CSI is proposing to amend Section 33-22-1316(1), MCA, to clarify that claims from the preceding benefit year that are not submitted for reimbursement by the annual submission date (established by the Board ) will not be reimbursed. We will provide continued status reports on the proposed legislation as it works its way through the 2023 legislature.
